

Reserving Housing

To reserve intern housing at Grand View University, please contact the Department of Housing at kmcillece@grandview.edu or 515-263-2884.

To ensure quality and timely service, please include a mailing address in your email, voicemail, or phone conversation and you will receive a housing application and housing contract in the mail. Fill out the forms and return them to Grand View University in the enclosed return envelope. All paperwork received by April 1 will ensure priority placement. Paperwork received after April 1 will be processed but placement will occur only as space allows. The housing application will assist the Grand View Residence Life Department in providing housing that best fits your needs and requests.

After your paperwork has been received, you will be informed of your housing assignment via email.

Move-in and Move-out Dates

Move-in is May 7, 2010, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Due to Grand View scheduling, interns will not be able to move in prior to May 7.

Final move-out will be July 31, 2010, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and Noon. Interns needing to leave prior to July 31 can make special arrangements with the Grand View Department of Housing.

Summer Intern Housing

The Greater Des Moines Partnership Intern Program is designed to accommodate local businesses, organizations, and educational institutions in the housing search for summer interns. Grand View University is committed to providing interns with a fun, safe, and inclusive environment while providing short-term housing. Interns may stay a maximum of three full months in the residential facilities on the Grand View campus.

The program enables interns to network with each other during their time in Des Moines when they're not working or studying. Components of the program include air-conditioned housing, fully-furnished accommodations, access to the Wellness Center, optional meal plans through the University food service, and social events provided by Grand View and the Des Moines Partnership.

Twenty-four-hour campus security and live-in summer residence life staff promote the safety, social, and emotional well-being of our residents. Residential issues and/or concerns will be handled smoothly and effectively with the staff and through procedures in place for summer housing.

With a diverse and inviting on-campus community comprised of summer interns and Grand View students, everyone will feel at home on campus.

The Wellness Center contains two recreational, full-size basketball courts and a three-lane, 1/10-mile jogging/walking track encircles a 20-station Cybex circuit training area. Open Monday – Friday, 6:30 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

10-meals-per-week Plan

The optional 10-meals-per-week plan is a great asset for interns living at Grand View. The time spent in our dining facilities enables interns to meet other interns on campus. They can get a sack lunch or have a hot breakfast before work and return for a hot dinner.

Breakfast: 7:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.

Lunch: 11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

Dinner: 6:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.

Housing Accommodations

Furnishings in all our residential spaces include a bed, dresser, desk, bookshelf, desk organizer, closet or wardrobe, free internet access, free basic cable television, and free local landline phone service.

Interns placed in the apartment complex also have a fully-furnished living area and kitchen unit (excluding dishware).

Interns placed in the student suites, our newest housing facility on campus, also enjoy a fully furnished living space.
